


Flight to Korea

- Flight itinerary should be shared with Hallym ISSO.
- If you do not join the airport pick up, you can come to Hallym University by yourself: either by bus, or by train.

Bus to Chuncheon

[Terminal 2]



- Limited number of airlines use the terminal 2, but if you arrive there, move to the transportation basement 1, buy a limousine bus ticket and take the bus at the bus stop no. 10.
- Bus departure time:
 - first bus 06:30
 - 40~50-minute interval
 - last bus 21:50

Bus to Chuncheon

- Most of foreign airlines arrive at the terminal 1.
- Buy a ticket for Chuncheon at one of the ticket offices Inside and outside the passenger terminal.
- ▶ Bus departure time: first bus 07:00 / 40~50-minute interval / last bus 22:20

[Terminal 1]



- N.B. Please have Korean cash ready to pay for the ticket (international cards may be declined) at both terminal 1 & 2.
- One-way Bus Fare: 24,100 KRW
- Chuncheon station is the last stop.

Take a limousine bus at the bus stop no. 13

Train to Chuncheon (subway + ITX)

- ▷ Incheon Airport Map : https://www.airport.kr/ap/en/map/mapInfo.do?TERMINAL=P01
- ▷ Take the Incheon Airport Railroad (공항철도) Express train : https://www.arex.or.kr/main.do
- **▷** Get off at Seoul Station and change the line to no.1 (dark blue line)
- > Arrive at Yongsan Station (just two station away)
- > Take ITX (different ticket) to Chuncheon station



Transportation to/in Seoul from Incheon Airport to Seoul Station

Machine to buy a transportation card : Press English on the screen









One-time usable card is refundable (deposit fee 500 won)

Transportation to/in Seoul from Incheon Airport to Seoul Station

- ▶ Discount if you buy a "T-money" card for consecutive use (rechargeable)
- Purchase at any convenience store in Seoul









Many different design & shapes (popular souvenir as well)









ITX from Yongsan station (in Seoul) to Chuncheon station

► ITX ticket is a separate train ticket (not a subway ticket) so you have buy it at Yongsan station (ticket counter or machine)

ITX signs to indicate its platform



- Be careful not to take a wrong train because the platform is shared with subway trains and those for other destinations.
- Check the train's departure time carefully and also your train & seat numbers




ITX-청춘 운행노선도

- Taxi stop is right outside
- Hallym University is approx. 5-minute ride away by taxi from Chuncheon station
- Taxi fare: 4,000~6,000 won (4~5 USD)
- Show this message to the driver if he/she does not speak English :

Dormitory Check-in & Useful Regulations

- ▶ Despite your arrival date in Korea, Hallym dorm check-in is allowed only between June 26 (Fri) – 28 (Sun)
- For tuition waivers: dorm fee should be paid before check in
- Dormitory space is limited and shared with a mate, so manage your luggage smartly
- Cooking with fire and gas is not possible due to safety issue, but you can use the microwave in the building
- Curfew exists: the entrance is closed between midnight and 5AM
- One use of the laundry machine costs a 500-won coin
- Alcohol & Smoking are not permitted
- ▶ 10,000 won fine for a lost or damaged key card
- Residents are responsible for their own personal valuables

Summer Weather in Korea

- ► Hot and humid & sometimes rainfall → Bring an umbrella (or raincoat)
- Strong air-conditioning inside buildings → Bring a light jacket

On-campus meal

- 2 Cafeterias open :
 - Sub-headquarter building 1F (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)
 - Campus Life Center 2F (Lunch and Dinner)
- Price : 4,000 won per meal

Off-campus meal

- ► There are many different kinds of restaurant around the campus
- ▶ Price range : 6,000 ~ 15,000 won (approx. 5~12 USD) per person











Health Insurance

- ▶ All participants are required to purchase a health insurance from home country before they arrive in Korea. Please make sure that your insurance covers possible incidents while staying 3 weeks in Korea.
- Bring a copy of your insurance certificate.
